- \$ 60 for a single day pass (24 hours; does not include run pin or bar)
- \$ 50 for an ACTIVE MEMBER
- \$ 80 for an ACTIVE MEMBER'S GUEST (*Limit 1 guest*)

PLEASE NOTE: All mail-in registrations must be postmarked by June 16, 2011.

After June 16th, NO CHECKS will be accepted and the run fee cannot be refunded. We will not check the PO Box after June 26th. Late registrations will be accepted at the KICK-OFF PARTY and must be paid in cash or by money order.

Please check one or more of the following:

- I will be riding my motorcycle to GFR from my hometown.
- I will be trailing my bike to GFR from my hometown.
- I will bring an RV to GFR (30' max. length) – *electricity is available for \$4.00 per day additional fee*
- I will be arriving at GFR by some other mode of transportation.

GFR Rules and related information

- GFR 37 will be held in a US Forest Service Campground in scenic Poudre Canyon, West of Ft. Collins, CO.
- This is a completely outdoor run, so bring your tent and sleeping bag, or an RV. Other items to think about include: lawn chair, campsite decorations for "Campsite Beautiful" contest which follows our yearly theme, snacks, insect repellent, etc. There is no need to bring cooking equipment, as all meals are provided.
- The run fee includes the KICK-OFF PARTY, 8 fabulous meals, beverages (unlimited beer, soda and water as well as cocktail parties throughout the weekend), activities, and run pin or year bar.
- Confirmation and directions will be sent upon receipt of this signed application form and the run fee.
- All Gay and Lesbian motorcycle enthusiasts are welcome. A motorcycle is not required for the run.
- Games, Campsite Beautiful Contest, Parade of Colors for those associated with other clubs or organizations and 4x4 excursions hosted by the 4-Players of Colorado are among the activities at GFR.
- **No illegal drugs.**
- Pets:
 - Pets are required to be quiet and well behaved.
 - Pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
 - Pet owners are required to clean up after their pet.
 - Pet owners are responsible for providing their pets' food and water. The camp's bottled water may not be used for pets.
 - Pets are not allowed on the hiking trails
 - Pets are never permitted in the kitchen/food preparation area.
 - Pets are not permitted in the pavilion while meals are being served.
